Dear Parents of 5th graders:

PHYSICAL EXAMS Connecticut General Statute Public Act 80-440, Section 10-206 requires a physical exam for school children in the 6th or 7th grade. Lisbon Central School requires a physical exam to be completed **in the 6th grade**. The physical exam must be done after January 1st of the 5th grade school year, but before the end of the 6th grade school year. (i.e. For the 2011/2012 school year, the exam must be done after 1/1/11 and before 6/1/12.) The results of this exam must be recorded on a State of CT blue health assessment form and returned to the nurse's office. Also, please be sure to complete the parent portion of the form.

IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED:

Tdap/Td	1 dose for students who have completed their primary DTaP series. Students who start the series at age 7 or older only need a total of 3 doses of tetanus-diphtheria containing vaccine, one of which must be Tdap.
Polio	At least 3 doses. The last dose must be given on or after 4 th birthday.
MMR	2 doses separated by at least 28 days, 1 st dose on or after the 1 st birthday
Meningococcal	1 dose
Hep B	3 doses, last dose on or after 24 weeks of age
Varicella	2 doses separated by at least 3 months, 1 st dose on or after the 1 st Birthday; or verification of disease

***** SPORTS PHYSICAL** Any student participating in after school sports must have a sports physical medical release form, within one year prior to the first practice. A sports physical is required **every year** your child is participating in sports. **Please Note:** The new State of CT blue health assessment form is an acceptable sports physical as long it is dated within 1 year prior to the first practice.
